Launch of ERONet System in NCT of Delhi

The Election Commission of India has launched ERONet, a web-based application in NCT of Delhi on 16.08.2017 based on Unified Electoral Roll Database which encompasses electoral roll records of entire Country.

ERONet is envisioned keeping in mind the mandate of ECI, that *no voter to be left* behind irrespective of his language or physical ability. The system strives to make an applicant's entry in e-roll unambiguous and error free without much of a hassle.

It is a National level Centralised System for Electoral Roll Management which brings all the electoral roll officers under single platform and provides easy migration of electors from one constituency to another by facilitating seamless communication between the EROs of two Assembly Constituencies in the country. This facility was not available in the earlier State level Electoral Roll Management System (ERMS) used for maintaining electoral roll of NCT of Delhi.

ERO-Net brings seamless processing of forms as all the stages of application forms processing are automated. It provides facility for interaction of EROs working in different parts of country for resolving different issues related with Electoral Roll management. It provides facility for checking multiple entries by running de-duplication engine, which supplements to EROs while approving/rejecting forms. All these features are the new improvements over the existing State level ERMS System.

Electors and Citizens will get the benefit of searching their name/part/serial no, submitting online applications of forms, track the status of filled application including auto alerts, details of Polling Station (PS)/Assured Minimum Facilities (AMF), get the details of Electoral Officers: BLO/Election Officer/AERO/ ERO, DEO & CEO, Step by step guide on enrolment & FAQs, Voluntarily furnishing information to ensure health of ER such as contact details, linking family members, enrolled family members' details, members going to become eligible for voter ID card (attains age of 18 years) in next summary revision, details of shifting/absent/dead of any elector etc. Voters entry in E-Roll are linked to their family information. It helps to allocate the polling booth so that whole family can vote at the same Polling Booth.

All the Election functionaries namely DEOs/EROs/AEROs etc have been trained at the CEO office, Delhi for smooth implementation of ERONet. This system enables easy monitoring of electoral roll related activities on various levels throughout the country.

Be a part of democratic process by registering your name in the electoral roll.
